Manufactured Housing in Cumberland County by Tom J. Keith

In 2001 our firm conducted a study of the Cumberland County manufactured housing market versus the conventional (stick built) home market. The study of stick built homes was limited to those less than 20 years old that sold for \$100,000 or less. The following table shows a statistical analysis and comparison between the manufactured homes and stick built homes based on data from the Fayetteville Area Board of Realtors.
